## **WORKSHOPS**

'Monoprinting' Saturday 17 February Tutor: Deb Walker Monoprinting is described as 'the painterly print'. This is a new workshop, limited to 9 people, where you will lay a transparent acrylic sheet over an image of choice, then paint what you see through the acrylic sheet using water based printing inks. You will experiment with mark making and different methods of applying and wiping away the ink painting before pulling a print on paper from it. I will provide images to use under your acrylic sheet for you to experiment with, but please feel free to bring your own A4 images as well. The day will be demonstration lead with tips and tricks along the way. Cost: £75 (to include use of printing inks and specialised equipment) Saturday 16 March 'Extending Creative Watercolour Textures' Tutor: Deb Walker Those who are familiar with watercolour know that the medium is very versatile when it comes to creating textures, by use of both additives and the 'laying on' of different found materials. This workshop will be demonstration lead, with a focus on new and different methods of laying materials into paint that naturally blend in to suggest observed textures in the natural world. Once dry, exciting images will emerge that you can take forward and work into to make a landscape painting. Cost: £75 (to include use of specialised materials)
